All Monitors need to be 2 way Monitors with 12"/1" configuration. Ideally 5 (five) individual mixes will be provided. In case this is not possible the band will at least require 2 individual monitor mixes and in any case Monitors 2 and 3 need to be SEPARATE MIXES. (EQ for monitors is essential!).

The band will require a 230 V feed on stage right for guitar player's pedals and middle front for accordion player's pedals.

230 V feed for bass amp and fiddle amp.

The Front of house mixer will need to have at least dual parametric EQ's per Channel and 24 full mono / microphone Inputs. Minimum requirement for smaller venues is 16channels). The House P.A. system will need to be 3-way with active crossover and capable to provide 100 dB of SPL on each seat throughout the entire auditorium.
